

Privacy Policy for Badminton Denmark

Badminton Denmark collects information about users, including and through their visits, and principally by the user submitting information for use in badminton activities.

Badminton Denmark commits itself to protecting and respecting users' privacy. The following is an explanation of Badminton Denmark's privacy policy. This policy is based on the recommendations jointly made by DIF/DGI which were based on common principle/practice at the time of preparation. All users of Badminton Denmark should read this privacy policy carefully.

Badminton Denmark's data responsibility

You can use our service, products, and related services in many different ways. When you do, we collect data.

We process personal information and have therefore adopted this Privacy Policy, which briefly describes how we treat your personal information to ensure fair and transparent processing.

Throughout our data processing, we only handle personal data for specific purposes and based on legitimate interests. We process only the personal information that is relevant and necessary for fulfilling the stated purposes and we will delete your information when it is no longer necessary. We collect this information to provide all our users with better assistance, products, services, etc.

Collection and processing of personal data

We process the following personal information:

- 1) Information on ordinary active recreational competitors, ordinary active competitors, inactive recreational competitors.
 - General Personal Information:
 - Registration and contact information such as name, gender, address, phone number, date of birth, e-mail address, age, nationality, account information/bank information.
 - Performance information from all badminton activities with recording of grade, category, ranking, club membership, regional affiliation for each active party.
 - Information provided by the user for statistical purposes, etc., in connection with ratings, reviews and other posts on electronic platforms, even when the user is not required to answer such questions. Information about the user's visits to electronic platforms, including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, and other communication data.
 - Photographs/images and video recordings associated with BADMINTON DENMARK activities.
 - Personal information provided with a higher degree of protection:
 - Visa information such as passport number, CPR number, period of stay, physical characteristics, etc.
 - Disability information, including history of illness and suchlike for Para-players.
 - Information about assigned yellow, red and/or black cards in connection with participation in individual tournaments or team tournaments, as well as information in connection with disciplinary action.
- 2) Information on non-salaried, uncompensated or non-expense-paid association member, association representative, manager/trainer.
 - General Personal Information:
 - Identification information such as name, gender, address and telephone number, date of birth, close family, current position, work tasks and assignments, timetables, schedules, contact hours, and other relevant circumstances.
 - Information about age, nationality.
 - Account/bank information.
 - Photographs/images and video recordings associated with BADMINTON DENMARK activities.
 - Personal information provided with a higher degree of protection:
 - Visa information such as passport number, CPR number, period of stay, physical characteristics, etc.
 - Information obtained by criminal background check about criminal offenses against juveniles.
- 3) Information about paid, compensated or expense-paid manager/trainer/association representative, staff, elite/national team player.
 - General Personal Information:
 - Identification information such as employee name, gender, address and telephone number, date of birth, close family, information about education, communications, previous employment, current position, tasks, working and/or contact hours, and other relevant information about salary/tax, absence due

- to illness and sick leave periods, information on other work absenteeism, pension status, tax withholding information, and information about the account number to which salary is to be deposited.
- Information about age, nationality.
- Details of payment information (including card type, number, expiration date).
- Photographs/images and video recordings associated with BADMINTON DENMARK activities.
- Personal information provided with a higher degree of protection:
 - CPR number.
 - Information from notes about staff and/or evaluation reviews with employees, including personality tests and suchlike.
 - Information about membership in a union, sick leave statistics, public applications for example, unemployment benefit information, etc.
 - Information about criminal offences and other situations of a purely private nature, such as that an employee has been expelled from work due to a serious breach of their employment relationship.
 - Information obtained by, for example, criminal background checks regarding criminal offences against juveniles.
 - Health conditions, injury reports, medical conditions, doping reports for players.
 - Information about treatment substances for players.
 - Visa information such as passport number, CPR number, period of stay, physical characteristics, etc.
 - Personality and other relevant tests.
 - Information about assigned yellow, red and/or black cards in connection with participation in individual tournaments or team tournaments, as well as information on sanctions in connection with disciplinary actions.

Where we collect information from

Normally we receive this information from you. However, in some cases, there may be other sources:

- Public and state authorities, for example, necessary tax information on payment of salaries, criminal background checks, visa approvals, etc.
- The primary organisations of the sport, as well as the primary national and international business partners, for example, information regarding competitiveness, elite and national team activities, club shifts, quarantines, and course participation, etc.
- Local and national clubs and associations, for example, information about participation in competitive activities, results from competitive activities, etc.

Purposes of processing your personal information

We process your personal information for specific purposes when we have a legitimate reason.

Common legal reasons for processing are:

- Badminton Denmark's rightful (legitimate) interest in processing your information (the balance of interest rule).
- Badminton Denmark's rightful (legitimate) interest in providing, maintaining, protecting and improving all our service, related services, activities, etc.
- When it is necessary to fulfil a contractual agreement or a gaming obligation with you.
- Processing according to legal requirements.
- Processing with consent.

The Objectives:

- 1) Purpose of processing information about ordinary active casual competitors, ordinary active competitors, passive casual competitors, etc.:
 - Handling of active members, active competitors, including registration fees, date of birth and year, registration of grade, category, ranking, club membership, regional affiliation, active status.
 - As part of Badminton Denmark's competitive activities and other activities, including planning, implementation, follow-up.
 - Delivery of goods and services you have ordered, including payments made in connection with purchases and to verify that the payment information provided is valid, and to provide the user with an overview of billing information, etc.
 - Administration of your relationship with us, including providing the user with the offers, news, information, products or services that the user requests or that Badminton Denmark considers to be of interest to the user concerned, where the user has consented to be contacted for such purposes.
 - Entrance to and exit from competitive activities.
 - To ensure that the content on Badminton Denmark platforms is presented in the most effective manner for the user and to communicate with the user most effectively.
 - To notify the user of changes in Badminton Denmark's service, rules, offers, etc.
 - The information allows us to analyse, adapt and improve our service offerings and communication with you. The information also allows us to provide you with the best possible user experience in the various areas you may use.

- 2) Purpose of processing information about unpaid, uncompensated or non-expense-paid association member, association representative, manager/trainer.
 - As part of Badminton Denmark's sports activities and other activities, including planning, implementation and follow-up.
 - Compliance with statutory requirements, including the Public Information Act.
 - Delivery of goods and services you have ordered.
 - Administration of your relationship with us.
- 3) Purpose of processing information about paid, compensated or expense-paid manager/trainer/association representative, staff, elite/national team player.
 - Managing manager/trainer/association representative, staff, elite/national team business and duties in and in accordance with Badminton Denmark's functions, duties and activities.
 - Overview and improvement of experience and competencies, including courses.
 - Compliance with legal requirements.
 - Payment of salaries, compensation, refunds and suchlike.
 - Administration of your relationship with us.

We process personal information based only on legitimate interests

To the extent that we process your information on the basis of balance of interest, this processing will be exclusively motivated by rightful (legitimate) interests such as:

- Performance of competitive badminton activities, including national as well as international individual/team performances, team card and team rosters, individual programmes, badminton results lists, rankings lists, classification, grading, categorisation, etc.
- Compliance with your duties and national as well as international rules/guidelines as an active member, including collection and payment of expenses, deposits, subscriptions, registration fees, etc.
- Information about individual and team competitions, as appropriate, is used on Badminton Denmark's, DIF's and DGI's data platforms in the form of rankings, dissemination of results, display of results, etc.
- Organisation of social events, sporting activities, badminton activities, and any other activities.
- Use of situational images and situational video taken in the context of badminton at Badminton Denmark's activities, competitions and events, depicting concrete activities or situations in a badminton context, competitive context or event context, including cropped, cut-out, zoomed and centred for use, also for use in collages.
- Situational images and situational video materials from individual and team competitions are used to the extent relevant to Badminton Denmark, DIF and DGI's data platforms and marketing platforms, including in the form of marketing of badminton, competitions, activities, invitations, programmes, magazines, etc.
- Portrait images are used only to the extent that specific consent is given and only for purposes where it is necessary or accepted, often where the user has self-uploaded the image, such as for employee profiles, etc., on Badminton Denmark's electronic platforms, access-providing ID cards for major events, etc.
- As Badminton Denmark is a member of sports organisations, information may be passed on.
 - Disclosure of your general personal information to DIF, DGI, divisional/regional, club organisers, etc., to the relevant and necessary extent in connection with sport activities and competitive activities.
 - Disclosure of information that entitles a player to perform his/her role as an active member in organisations such as Badminton World Federation (BWF), BEC (Badminton Europe Confederation), IOC (International Olympic Committee), Team Denmark, Anti-Doping Denmark, etc., based on their legal requirements for participation.
- For practical and administrative reasons, we will also keep your general information for a period after your immediate withdrawal, termination, etc.
- Regarding children and adolescents less than 18 years of age, information about parents/guardians may be processed for the sake of contact.
- Preservation of information with historical value for statistical and similar use.
- Information of a sensitive nature is only recorded with personal consent, including the recording of sensitive information, if it is necessary to comply with provisions in a law or executive order issued pursuant to law.

Consent

Most often, our processing of your personal data will be based on a legitimate basis other than consent. Therefore, we only obtain your consent when it is, in rare cases, necessary to process your personal information for the purposes described above.

If we obtain your consent, your agreement is voluntary and you may withdraw it at any time by notifying us.

When we collect personal information about children and adolescents, we assess whether the child is able to provide the relevant personal information. If not, we will obtain consent from a parent/guardian. Our starting point is 15 years. If we collect personal information on children through information services (apps and social media), children can give their own consent from the age of 13.

Dissemination of your personal information

In connection with sporting activities, information about participation and performance is passed on to sports organisations and organisations such as DIF, DGI, BWF, BEC, IOC, Team Denmark, Anti-Doping Denmark and suchlike.

Competition information is provided to the relevant extent to sports organisations and organisations such as DIF, DGI, BWF, BEC, IOC, Team Denmark, Anti-Doping Denmark, etc.

Information about individual and team competitions is published to the relevant extent on Badminton Denmark, DIF, DGI, BWF, BEC data platforms in the form of rankings, determination of results, dissemination of results, etc.

Common situational images of adults and children practising their sporting and social activities from and in sport/badminton activities and from Badminton Denmark's association-related social life are displayed on Badminton Denmark's digital and print media. It is primarily aimed at promoting, reporting and disseminating results from badminton. Even when the individual can be recognised. We do not use situational images that can exhibit or violate a person.

Images and video materials from individual and team competitions are published on Badminton Denmark's platforms in conjunction with marketing of the sport and activities, etc.

DIF, DGI, BWF, BEC data platforms and marketing platforms receive images and video materials, in particular, in relation to storytelling about badminton and badminton-related activities, including in the form of marketing of badminton, competitions, activities, invitations, programmes, magazines, etc.

We do not disclose personal data to companies for marketing without your consent.

Storage and deletion of your personal information

We always work to ensure information security, and use technical and organisational security measures to protect stored personal information against unauthorised access and use. To the extent that we share personal information with third parties, we place corresponding security requirements on them. To the extent that we have stored information of a sensitive nature, such information is only available to relevant persons with need for access to this information.

If you have logged in to My Profile on BadmintonPeople, for example, and have been inactive for a certain period of time, we will automatically sign you out to protect your account from unauthorised access.

With Badminton Denmark, you are primarily responsible for keeping your own login and user information (username and password) confidential and up to date.

We have different processing purposes and storage periods depending on whether we handle your personal information as:

- 1) Ordinary active casual competitor, ordinary active competitor, inactive casual competitor.
- 2) Unpaid, uncompensated or non-expense-paid member, association member, association rep./leader/trainer.
- 3) Paid, compensated or expense-paid manager/trainer/association representative, staff, elite/national team player.

Note 1

- We will only keep personal information which is in accordance with your achieved results and placings, hereunder and hereby for practical, historical and statistical purposes. This information is not deleted.
- For practical and administrative purposes, we store your remaining personal data in relation to competition for up to 5 years after you have not been active in a competitive activity in badminton.
- Information of a sensitive nature is stored only 1 year after expiration of the current requirement.
- Specific portrait pictures used for international Event id-cards will only be stored for the duration of the planning, running and evaluation of the Event

Note 2

- For practical and administrative reasons, we keep your personal information for a period from the end of your work up to 2 years after your work has ended.
- We will store your personal information, which is in accordance with your educational status as judge, trainer, etc., so that you can always continue a course of education at a later date. This information is not deleted.
- Information regarding visas, etc., is stored for only 1 year after expiration of the current need, for the sake of security.
- Specific portrait pictures used for international Event id-cards will only be stored for the duration of the planning, running and evaluation of the Event

Note 3

- Billing attachments, hereunder, for example, wage statements, must be stored for a period from the end of your work for 5 years from the end of the financial year to which the statement refers.

- Other relevant information for follow-up and disposition of any requirements is stored for 5 years after the work has ended.
- Information of a sensitive nature is stored only 1 year after expiration of the current need, for the sake of security.
- We will keep your personal information, which is in accordance with your educational status as judge, trainer, etc., so that you can always continue a course of education at a later date. This information is not deleted.
- We will store your personal information, which is in accordance with your achieved results and placings, for practical, historical and statistical purposes. This information is not deleted.
- Specific portrait pictures used for international Event id-cards will only be stored for the duration of the planning, running and evaluation of the Event

We always store information about active members, inactive members, leaders and trainers for statistics and suchlike, for as long as they have historical value.

Your rights

You have a number of special rights under the General Data Protection Regulation when we process personal information about you:

- The right to be informed about the processing of data.
- The right to access personal data.
- The right to correction.
- The right to delete:
 - However, not personal data and images that are in accordance with achieved results and placings, hereby for practical, historical and statistical purposes.
 - However, not legally-conditional information, where rules regulate use.
- The right to restrict processing.
- The right to data portability (data transmission in a commonly-used format)
- The right to object.

You may exercise your rights, including objections to our processing, by contacting us. You can find our contact information above.

If, for example, you request correction or deletion of your personal information, we will investigate whether the conditions are met and, in that case, make changes or deletions as quickly as possible.

You can always file a complaint with a data protection authority, for example, the Data Protection Agency.

Cookies, IPs, networks, tags, etc.

We use Google Analytics, among other methods, to improve our service, services, etc. to all our users.

We use cookies on BadmintonPeople for your convenience.

Cookies are small text files used on BadmintonPeople to make it function as well as possible and to collect statistics about how the page's content is used by you and other visitors.

1. Functional cookies

Functional cookies are placed to make the website function more effectively. Functional cookies are divided into two categories:

The necessary cookies are used to make a website function, for example, by remembering what you have in the shopping cart, how far you have completed filling out a form, remembering password by login or the like.

Cookies for added functionality and ease of use are used to enable a website to remember the choices you have made, including, among others, your entered preferences such as language, region, or suchlike. The functional cookies are also those that are set to share content across websites, such as on Facebook, etc.

2. Web analytics and optimisation

We use cookies for web analytics. These cookies are used to gather statistics about how visitors use the website. By looking at where visitors come from, what pages they see and how they use the content and features of the website, we can subsequently improve the website. The information collected is used anonymously and as a tool for the web team.

3. Targeted marketing and profiling

These cookies can be used for the exchange of user information across websites/services and the information may affect various third parties. This allows third parties to use cookies to profile in a broader sense.

Disable cookies

If you wish to opt out of cookies now or in the future, you can do this via your browser settings. You can block cookies from this and other websites by adding the domain under Internet Settings in your browser. Read more on how to opt out of cookies via your browser at mincookies.org.

What happens if I disable cookies?

If you disable cookies using your browser settings, your movements on the website will not be registered when you click. However, you should be aware that by disabling cookies you will also automatically disable some of the functionality of many websites and therefore they will not work properly.

We inform about cookies because we, like all other Danish websites, are required to inform about them according to the following link:
